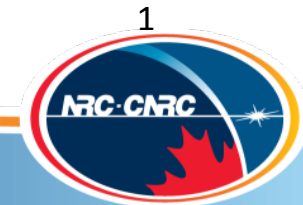

Productivity:

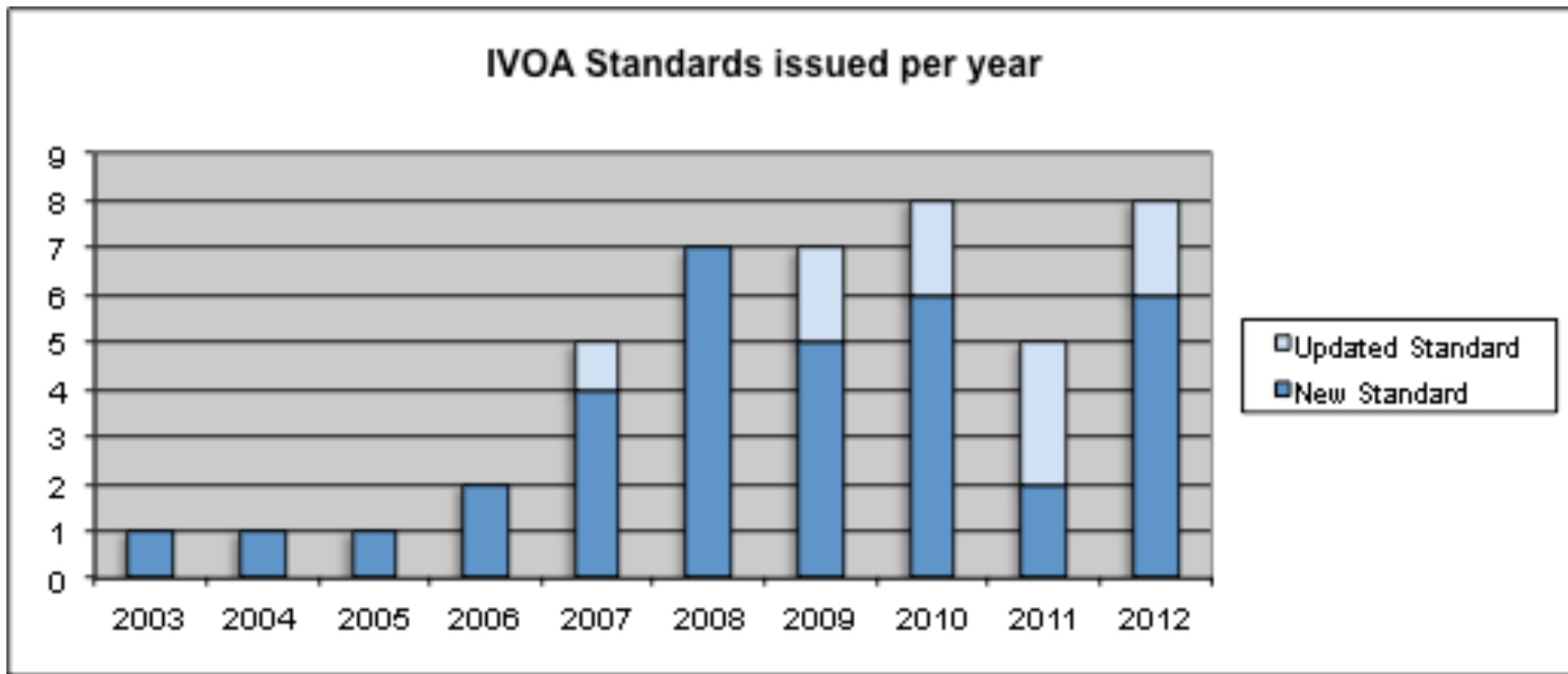
- Many individuals continue to make contributions which should earn them “Hero of the Virtual Observatory” status.

Highlights from member projects:

Argentina: NOVA

- Starting to manage survey data (VISTA and HI)
- Plate scanning
- Nova Workshop June 2013 had 70 participants
- AstroGrid

AstroGrid

- Now an informal project with UK VO staff working through EURO-VO projects and through data centre and mission activities (VISTA, GAIA, ALMA, EUCLID)
- Latest initiative is Astrotrop: tropical rainforest monitoring





Highlights from member projects:

China-VO

- Opening the first WWT planetarium on October 21st
- China-VO and AstroInformatics 2013 workshop will be held in November with involvement of IT companies

Canadian Virtual Observatory

- Working on datacubes, datalink
- Major migration of our data collections to CAOM-2 which will support VO functionality





Highlights from member projects:

EURO-VO

- CoSADIE activities include engagement with data providers
- VO school for PhDs and post-docs held Feb 5-7 in Madrid
- GAVO hosted a Data Centre Forum in June
- Active in Educations and Outreach
- Research Data Alliance (FrancoiseGenova)

France-VO

- Annual meeting March 11-12 in Paris
- VO Theory, planetary and heliopheric physics using VO tools
- IVOA work continues at CDS, Paris, Toulouse





Highlights from member projects:

GAVO

- Runs data centres in Potsdam and Heidelberg
- IVOA: relational registry, datalink prototype, server side, manipulation of spectra
- CoSADIE Data Centre Forum in Heidelberg in June

Vobs.it

- VO for Education and Outreach
- Relational Registry, OGF Distributed Computing Infrastructures
- Engage with radio astronomy for access to multi-dimensional data

SVO

- Healthy: 7 FTE's
- SVO Thematic Network (institutes with interest in VO) is composed of almost 200 participants from 30 labs
