2 Reminder of IVOA Recommendation Process

A WG chair can submit any working draft to the IVOA repository. It is recommended that any WD that could be implemented should be submitted.

We need two views of the Document page:

- 1. A view with only the recommended and the latest WD/PR
- 2. A complete view with history (the current view)

It would be good to add the REC date of the document in the tooltip.

The IVOA Document coordinator should be kept in the loop around process questions

CA explained the whole recommendation process, specifically the role of the Working Chair from the start of the PR submission to the IVOA Document coordinator through to TCG review of the PR. The final version of a WD should be available to the WG for 4 weeks prior to starting the PR process.
