Apps news

- **Hips Hips Hips ...**

- HiPS network has now 20 HiPS nodes. + 7 since last meeting in US, Canada, China, Australia
- 4 news HiPS clients, notably the well known Firefly and Stellarium
- HiPS forum uses Apps mailing list

- **Tools and lib releases:**

- ADQL, UWS and TAP-Lib (March 2018: ADQL-Lib 1.4, UWS-Lib 4.2 and 4.3, TAP-Lib 2.1 and 2.2)
- TOPcat (May 2018: TOPCAT v4.6-1, STILTS v3.1-4, STIL v3.3-1)



Apps Standards news

- **Errata VOTable 1.3**
 - Erratum_2 “Permitting F0 in precision attribute in FIELDS” → adopted
 - Erratum_3 “Clarification on arraysize="1" → still in discussion
- **WD of VO-DML mapping in VOTable** (23 March 2017).
