### Developer Document View

- Prototype project to produce "modern" more easily readable multi-device compatible "view" of existing documentation aimed at developers.
- Uses <u>pandoc</u> to transform existing document source into a structure delivered using <u>sphinx</u>
- Aims
  - reduce the inter-document click count from 4 to 1.
  - remove some of the boilerplate front-matter.
  - provide a structure that makes top-down navigation easier.
  - present the latest REC or WD i.e. source is from GitHub
- Explicitly **not** trying to replace existing standards publishing
  - but can feedback lessons on document consistency







## Lessons Learned

- Paper is not really the principal delivery medium nowadays
  - content style will be driven by the delivery medium.
- Document source code format will also create difficult to translate structures to other formats
  - Authors will try to tweak output to look good with the facilities available in the original format
  - Really need to concentrate on semantic structuring.
- Diagram source often missing
  - standardize on draw.io?
  - or text -> diagram tools such as plantuml or mermaid





## Future development

- Fix existing translation errors
  - sometimes this might mean tweaking the source of the original document is the best solution.
- Add more documents
  - where to stop?
  - what if an important document is not in GitHub?
- Add some structure to the landing pages
  - possibly adopt some overview text from various WG wiki pages
  - better version of architecture diagrams? Architecture Note has some diagrams that explain relationships between standards better.
