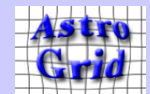

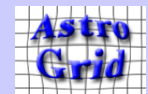
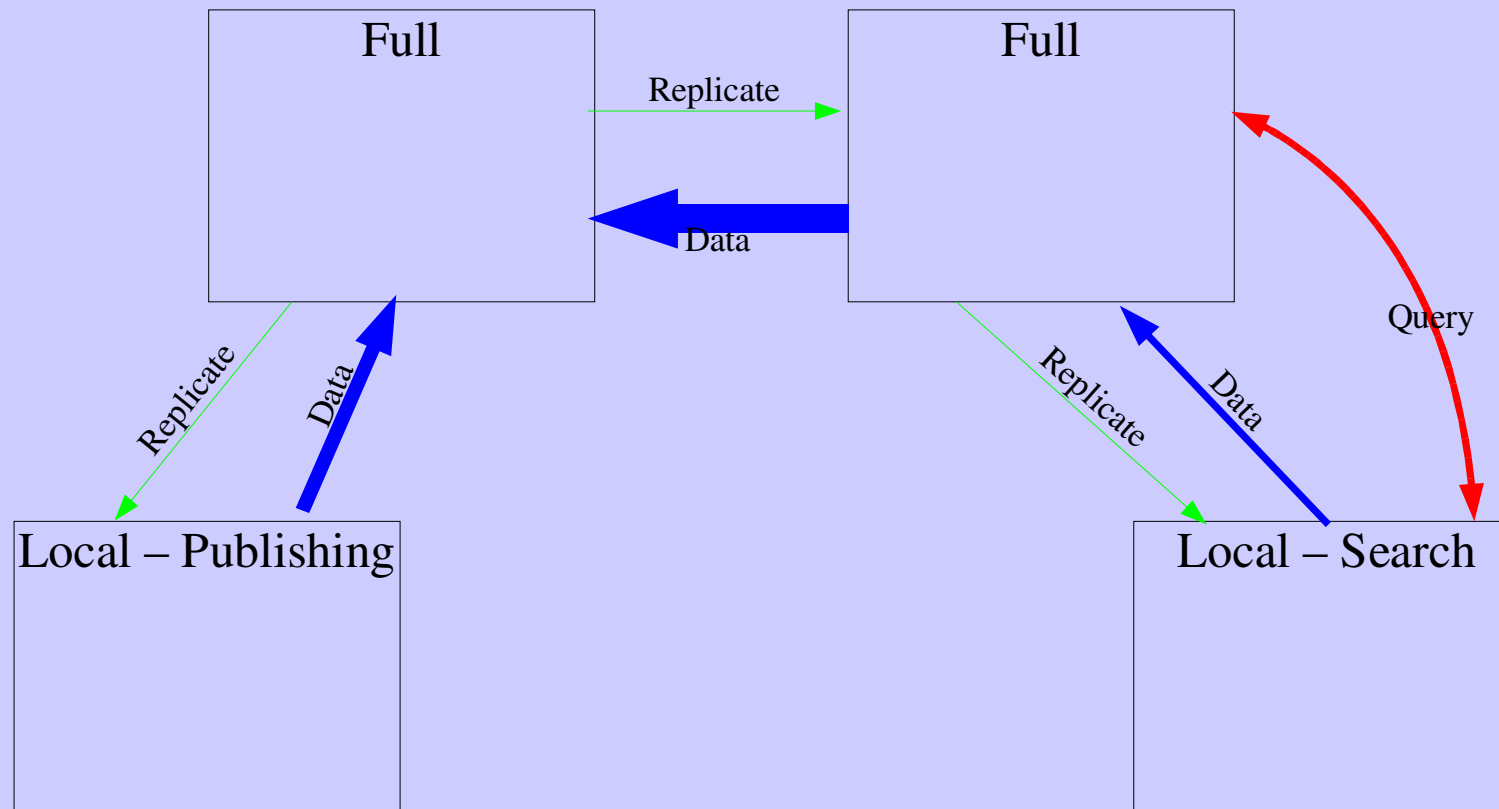


Assumptions

- A Registry is just another VOResource
- Resource metadata = Registry data
- Registries hold metadata about themselves
- Registries can be queried for their metadata i.e. Registries support the harvest mechanism (like any other VOService – but how do we know a resource supports harvesting?).

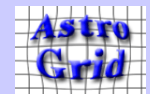


Types and Mechanism



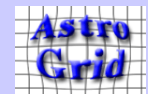
For AAS

- Use HTTP Get (OAI style)
- Specify “since” date in Replicate call
- Registry returns all its data (metadata) with an Update Date later than the “since” date
- Data returned will be formatted according to VOResource schema.



Future Consideration

- Replicate via Web Service interface
 - OAI web service?
- Resource harvesting
 - Web service?
 - HTTP GET?
- Resource attributes:
 - DoNotReplicate
 - DeletedResource



Summary
