1. Roll Call and Agenda

The participants introduced themselves and their names were recorded.

2. IVOA Web Page and Document Repository transfer

BB reported on the status of migrating the Web Pages and Document repository to other IVOA partners. Sarah Emery Bunn (SEB) is assisting with the transfer. The following was decided at a Feb 12 Exec telecon:

Website/Document Repository – VO-India – Sharmad Navelkar (SN)

Wiki/Mail list/Domain Name - VObs.it - Marco Molinaro (MM)

Newsletter – SAO – Gus Muench (GM)

Backup of Website/Document Repository – China-VO – Chenzhou Cui

The schedule driver is the VAO closeout review on Jul 10-11. The parties agreed to make a best effort to complete the transfer by Jun 06 providing a margin to the closeout. The exception is the Backup; it is recommend that VO China contact VO India and VObs.it after the transfer is complete to organize backup procedures.

BB reported considerable progress has been made. The Website has been successfully migrated to VO-India and testing is in progress. A script for uploading documents has been deployed and SEB & SN are currently performing tests. Document Coordinator instructions have been prepared and are undergoing review.

The Wiki content has been transferred. The two domains (ivoa.net, ivoa.info) have been transferred to VObs.it along with authoritative name servers. Transfer of services is planned next.

SEB has been working with GM to assemble and publish the Spring IVOA Newsletter. Issue 012 was published May 15, 2014. The newsletter handover is completed.

3. Status of VO efforts in the US post-VAO

BH reported that the end of the VAO contract is at the end of Sep 2014. NASA will support VAO services and ongoing support of the IVOA from the NASA archive centers at STScI, HEARSARC, and IPAC. Sustaining activities are as follows: Registry – STScI; Resource Validation – HEASARC; Represent NASA at Exec – IPAC.

BH also noted that there is a proposal (worked by Pepi, Bob, Jay Gallagher) to form the USVOA as part of the AAS Working Group on Astronomical Software (WGAS). Frossie Economou is the new chair of the WGAS. Ethan Schrier will present the proposal at the AAS Council meeting in June. There is no financial support associated with any approval. If it is approved, the WGAS will name a lead and that person will represent the USVOA on the Exec. No revision to Exec rules needed.

4. Review expiring Working Group Chair/Deputy Chair positions

SG noted that the ImageDM is a critical component of SIAv2. He expressed that the ImageDM needs to be completed and requested that the Exec establish the importance of the ImageDM in the IVOA. It was also noted that the ImageDM was NOT needed for SIA v2.0 but was needed for near-term planned revisions to SIA v2.x.

AGREED: The Exec identified ImageDM as the highest priority for the DM WG.

MG asked MA if the minimum requirements of SIA v2.0 satisfy all of the use cases brought forward by the CSP. MA responded that the minimum requirements for SIA v2.0 do not satisfy all of the use cases but that it is good enough for v2.0.

SG is looking for ImageDM PR by the Fall IVOA meeting. MG added the IVOA Roadmap reflects the TCG plans. There is already a TCG action to update the Roadmap by the end of next week.

MA reported on the Multi-Dimensional Data Focus Session. This year's session is followon with the projects that participated in Heidelberg last year. There is interest in continued engagement with these projects. The next steps to refine for multi-dimensional Images are cutouts & binning and remote computation and transfer of cubes.

MA also reported that there was an informal CSP meeting on Wed (5/21). They concluded that the CSP approach to develop multi-dimensional image science use cases and transform them to requirements worked well. MA highlighted that the other current focus area is 'Time Domain'. Rough plans were made to review priorities and develop science use cases.
