### **4. Project Reports [Significant Events]**

- **CA – Gaia DR2** in April was a big success of VO; the VO is transparent to users. CC added, 24 hours after the Gaia release it was mirrored to China and teams worked on the cross match of Gaia to SkyServer.
- **CC** – There is an upcoming **conference in Beijing on Gaia/Lamost data** using the Gaia mirror site and the Lamost database.
- **MD - Registry Queries** spiked after the press release of Gaia DR2. MD noted that it is important to plan that data is harvested from the registry up front so the data is available for the deluge. Projects can do this by contacting the Registry WG for big releases.

- **FP – European Science Open Forum** - Will be held in Trieste May-Jun 2020. The event is multi-disciplinary, but it would be a good place to display VO activity. One of the themes is Big Data and VO would be a big topic.
- **FG – Tech forum** – There was a VO/Asterics meeting in April; It is the beginning of the last year of Asterics funding; A European Data providers meeting is planned in Heidelberg in June – with a goal of gathering requirements from projects not involved in Asterics.
- **MA – Euro School** planned for later in the year. Project will have a multi-messenger. This is the last year of a 4 year project in Asterics.
- **PF - USVOA** – At the AAS meeting in January and also planned for June NAVO is conducting Python schools to interest attendees with hands on practice using IVOA standards/tools in Python. There has been an interest by LSST in IVOA and Tim Jenness from LSST has joined the US contingent as a new Exec member (replacing Adam Bolton). The Chandra Source Catalog is nearing processing completion. DATA access via ESASky and WWT are planned.
- **BC – Euro Planetary (Asterics Solar System)**. Workshop in Prague / A DACH server was setup at the University of Iowa. It was started 3 years ago and now has smooth operations.

## 5. ***Approval of new IVOA Recommendation(s) [Standing Items]***

Two recent Exec approval request had questions from the Exec to the TCG associated with them that were discussed. PD presented the following:

- **VOResource 1.1** – editorial change to specification after submissions to Exec. No impact. Common practice in XML modeling.
- **VOspace 2.1** – DAL WG approved the standard after submission to Exec. Both explanations were acceptable to the Exec and the standards were approved.

## 6. ***Overall TCG Status***

MG highlighted recent TCG activities.

- There was a TCG face to face meeting the morning of May 27.
- The Schema versioning endorsed note was approved by the TCG.
- There was a side meeting setup on additional Endorsed Notes.
- Discussed maintenance of vocabularies – Semantics group will discuss details this week.
- Migration to GitHub
  - Agreed to GitHub for standards development and issue tracking
  - Solves transparency
  - Will use ADQL 3.0 as a prototype and inform the process; Parallel effort to consider best practice. PD & DM will report at the next meeting.
- The TCG approved the Erratum
- Will also look at the best way to tell community that a standard has an erratum
- TCG Home page will be included in the VO web pages review / come back in 6 months
  - Ops group will take the lead on the review
- IVOA architecture document represents a number of purposes
  - The current doc is 8 years old; there are maintenance issues
  - The doc needs a review and refresh
  - TCG and the Docs&Stds group will take it up as an Endorsed note

- TCG face to face meeting planned at the start of the next Interop given the large changeover in personnel. The first ½ morning of the IVOA will be scheduled as a TCG meeting and there will be a late morning start for the regular IVOA sessions.

**7. Update to the main IVOA web page with an IVOA Vocabularies Page. (M Louys).**

ML presented a prototype page to the Exec for consideration. The goal is to gather all vocabularies used in the IVOA framework and manage the various updates to these collections of terms for uniformly. The location of this page will be linked from the top level of the IVOA landing page. The plan is for the Semantics WG to maintain the Vocabulary page and make it visible. FG requested that there be a link to the standard that uses the vocabulary. **The Exec agreed to the page.**

**8. Overall CSP Status**

BM reported that there hasn't been a lot of activity in the CSP but he was planning to activate the group at the Interop. A Focus Session on IVOA/Astropy synergies is planned at the Interop and a goal is to encourage more participation among the members.

**Raffaele D'Abrusco was nominated to the CSP.** MA reminded the group that the Exec decides who is on the CSP. **The Exec approved the nomination.**

**9. Future Interops**

- **Northern Autumn 2018 - College Park, MD (Nov 8-10);** (ADASS Nov11-18) - (T McGlynn)
  - TM reported on the next IVOA meeting in College Park, Maryland. The IVOA will be held before ADASS. It will be at the same hotel as ADASS. The Exec meeting will be held the first night of the IVOA meeting. IVOA signup will be through the ADASS site with a checkbox for IVOA.
- **Northern Spring 2019 - Paris FR (May 12-17)** (B Cecconi)
  - BC presented a slide and highlighted the following information:
  - **LOC** (still TBC): P. Lesidaner, B. Cecconi, C.-M. Zwölf, R. Haigron, M. Servillat
  - **Rooms:** Several options for plenary session rooms in PSL University institutes (in the Latin quarter, near Panthéon). Splinter sessions at ObsParis (near Denfert Rochereau) - Easy transfer by bus or subway; cars will be available for persons needing assistance
  - **IPDA steering committee** meeting also organized at Obs Paris, just before: from Wednesday 8th to Friday 10<sup>th</sup>
  - **Note: Add Mireille Louys to the LOC**
- **Northern Autumn 2019** – Netherlands (with ADASS)
- **Northern Spring 2020** – FP asked if there are any objections to have it in Trieste Italy. It could be a preparatory event for ESOF 2020. There should be a new conference center at that time: we need to investigate if it could be used for the Interop.
