1. Roll Call and Agenda

- BM outlined that the CSP would be focusing on 3 topics:
 - Contact with Big Projects
 - Developing Science Use Cases

- DS raised that Authentication and Authorization needed CSP attention to develop use cases

She suggested a paper could be led by the Asterics project members with other projects/authors participating. Several Exec members offered to contribute.
