### 6. Overall CSP Status and Relevant Items for Upcoming Interop

- All recommendations and endorsed notes should be published on ADS (where they get a DOI) and into FAIRSharing. MA mentioned that having them into FAIRSharing is important as it is being looked at by the European Commission as an output of VOrelated projects the Commission is funding (i.e., recent ESCAPE project). There should be a review/audit of the list from the past year.
  - The TCG should make sure they are entered into FAIRSharing by comparing its contents to ADS and noting the discrepancies.

 New Action assigned to PD to review the list of recently approved IVOA Recommendations and Endorsed Notes, and check they have both been properly entered into ADS and FAIRSharing.

### 7. IVOA-IAU Liaison Group

- CA summarized the situation of the groups in this context which are:
  - 1. An already existing IAU Functional Working Group under Division B (Facilities, Technologies, and Data Science), for which we would like to create an Organizing Committee to increase its visibility in the IAU. BB drafted the charter for it.
  - 2. An IVOA-IAU Liaison Group, to coordinate activities and promote cooperation with the IAU, chaired by BB and for which we should finalize its charter.
- GBB sent the draft terms of reference for the Organizing Committee of the IAU Functional Working to Giovanni, the President of IAU Division B, who endorses the proposal with a recommendation that committee members should be involved in the broader activities of the IAU.
  - Staffing for the committee is to be determined.
  - We have submitted a proposal for a focus session for the 2024 General Assembly: "Community Engagement and Open Science in the VO."
  - o A decision on our proposal will be made in late May or early June 2023.
  - BB extends his thanks to PW for her advice and support with drafting the documents. Both documents: 90% completion
- Franck, Marco, Joachim, Mark, Fabio, and Simon are all IAU members.
  - BB says the typical committee size is 5-6 people; WG have considerable latitude to staff them as they see fit.
  - We agreed that we should aim to have 50/50 membership (IVOA:IAU)
  - BB says you do not have to be a fully accredited member; if you're a member of both IVOA and IAU then you're a perfect candidate for the liaison group.
- JE: How will this group operate? How will it work and what will we get out of it? Request a paragraph summarizing this.
  - o CA: The goal from the IVOA's POV is to improve our visibility within the IAU and bring what we have to offer to a very broad community in astronomy.
  - o The documents BB is drafting will provide more clarity.
- **New Action:** All Exec to send BB and SO the names of potential candidates to serve on the Organizing Committee of the IAU Functional Working.
- New Action: GBB to finalize the charter for the IVOA-IAU Liaison Group

  summary at the top of the page. Dedicated discussion and feedback took place at the
  TCG earlier on today, and CA brought to the Exec the main feedback and updated the
  Twiki page accordingly.
  - The image on the home page could have a rotation of images that represent space and data. To minimize work for the web team, the images would change twice a year before Interop meetings.
  - This would fall under the Media group, which has been relatively inactive; the newsletter hasn't been updated since March 2022.
  - CA suggests sending an email to IVOA Document Coordinator with a list of applications to be added to the website (<u>VO Applications for Astronomers page</u>).
  - Code of Conduct should be more prominent on the home page.

## Australia-VO (ASVO)

We are currently looking at ways to link better with the various astronomy data centres in Australia, as there are several groups that are not connected to the ASVO (e.g., gravitational waves, theory/simulations).

At this stage, we will be forming an Astronomy Data Coordination Group, which will link with the ASVO. The goal is to broaden the reach of the VO to these other communities and encourage their uptake of the various standards and processes.

 Pursuing FAIR standards for CfA data: A recent meeting with SMA and NRAO to exchange information on formats and standards; working to map Obscore keywords to SMA Radio data; also Obscore review and use in Chandra—performed inventory and reviewed if a high energy extension is needed.

- Work on Science Platform IR&D project using Rubin Science Platform application for CfA use— Instatiated the Platform at CfA—coordinating with RSP lead on topics to discuss/resolve before conclusions are made.
- Populating DOIs in Chandra Source Catalog 2.1 production run and migrating previous catalog products (CSC 2.0) to current DOI format.
- Contribute to IVOA DM pursuits: MIVOT 1.0, Spectrum DM RFE, moving forward on Dataset and Transform, which will lead when completed to a data cube model. Data Cube model will support 1-,2-, and 3-dimensional data including the event list used by photon-counting, high-energy projects (e.g., Chandra).
- Initiated HIPs project to automatically produce HIPs for Standard Processing at TBD cadence; thinking about HIPS for the Chandra Source Catalog next.
- All Chairs/V Chairs to TCG & IGs contributed to Interop planning and presentations.
