## **Discussion**

## 1. Roll Call and Agenda

### 2. Renewal of WG/IG Chairs and Vice-chairs, continued (as needed)

CA reported on the many discussions with all potential candidates. He mentioned that people feel honored and motivated to be offered a position. Some other people also declined due to their project workload but would be happy to be considered in the future.

The Exec is conscious of various considerations to be taken into account in the nominations for these positions, among them being:

- The need to balance experience in the IVOA while also bringing new and younger people in these positions. Ideally, this can be done in the decision between chairs and vice-chairs.
- The need to ensure good diversity and gender balance within the TCG.
- The need to have people who can commit their time in fulfilling these roles.
- For IGs, it is important to have a scientist as the Chair who is able to represent and engage the community. Having a Vice-Chair with more engineering expertise enables a good combination.

The Exec reviewed all of the proposed names for these positions and concluded on the following ones:

- DM WG VC: Matthieu Servillat (ObsParis, CTA)
- GWS Chair: Jesus Salgado (SKAO)
- GWS VC: Sara Bertocco (INAF)
- Operations Chair: Steve Groom (IPAC, IRSA)
- Operations VC: Tamara Civera (CEFCA, Spain)
- For Semantics WG Chair and Vice-Chair, the Exec felt the candidates should be asked about their respective roles (chair or vice-chair). Just after the meeting, CA checkes with them and confirmed:
  - Semantics WG Chair: Baptiste Cecconi (ObsParis)
  - Semantics WG VC: Sebastien Derriere (CDS)
- Time Domain IG Chair: Rafael Martínez-Galarza (CfA)
- Solar System IG VC: Markus Demleitner (GAVO)
- Theory IG VC: Giuliano Taffoni (INAF)
- Radio Astronomy IG Chair (one year): François Bonnarel (CDS)
  - o For one year only, as he will then go on retirement

CA will inform all these people, as well as the other candidates who were not selected, and will make the corresponding announcements at the closing session.

For the Radio Astronomy IG Vice-Chair, two potential names were mentioned, but more information is needed, and the corresponding VO national projects representatives were not present. The decision could not be finalized. CA will contact them to gather such information and allow the Exec to take the decision at the next Exec meeting.

For the Time Domain IG Vice-Chair, no name was proposed at the time of the meeting, so we will still have to find potential candidates. [Notes from after the meeting: on the next day, a potential candidate came forward, so CA will bring this to the Exec for decision at the next Exec meeting].
