4. Project Reports

- NOVA project office discussion items (SG)
 - Digitization of historic photometric and spectrophotometric Cordoba plates with the Chinese VO and WEB 5 interfacing protocol, lightning on Nostr to facilitate incentive system to optimize extraction of scientific value.
 - There are ~8,000 plates
 - Seeking assistance from China VO to help with the plates; in touch with Zhen Hong and Chenzhou whose team has digitized a lot of plates
 - Exploring options of using Nostr Protocol, a Web 5 concept
 - No questions from Exec.

5. Overall TCG Status

- The TCG last met on Wed., July 26 at 13:00 UTC with about 25 members in attendance (last mtg held was June 26)
- At the June meeting, we welcomed new TCG members, set up their accounts/access, identified important links, provided links to a TCG primer doc, and reviewed May Interop feedback.
- At the meeting yesterday, we:
 - o voted on SODA 1.0 Erratum 3 and will focus next on Datalink v1.1
 - Reviewed Roadmap status (https://wiki.ivoa.net/twiki/bin/view/IVOA/2023ARoadmap) and had 2 WG (GWS, Apps) & 2 IG (SS, Operations) review their plans.
 - Of note GWS presented a design diagram where interoperability standards with science platforms could be focused; plans to expand details, discuss, and present at the fall meeting—a good next step given the plenary sessions in spring.
- Next TCG meeting set for Sept. 06 at 20:00 UTC
 - o Review several more roadmaps.
 - o Identify actions that need to get started for upcoming Fall Interop.

- It's time to finalize the documents that BB distributed.
- BB has received comments from a few members; most recently comments from RN that BB has not had a chance to incorporate into the draft.
 - o RN's comments touched on the length of the terms.
 - The term is three years with a possible extension.
 - New action for BB to clarify the three-year terms in the document.
- BB said the IAU Div B President Gabriele Giovannini said the VO charter is looking good. He would like a committee that includes broader members of the IAU community who are interested in advancing the VO. BB concurs.
- Gabriel is planning a one-day division B session opened to open science and has asked BB to be on the LOC; BB has accepted the invitation.
- CA asked if Exec endorses the two notes.

- Note that as of the May Interop meeting, the USVAO member rotation for the IVOA exec has taken place. Robert Nikutta from NOIRLAB, representing the ground-based OIR community in the USA, is the new Exec member replacing Mark Lacy (NRAO) from the Radio community.
- CfA /Chandra
 - Won extended <u>CfA</u> contract for year 2 of a Science Platform IR&D project using the Rubin Science Platform application for <u>CfA</u> use - installed on GCP, have several prototype use cases working.
 - JE/IE worked with SMA (Radio) group to extend their knowledge of IVOA as part of a Smithsonian Big Data Project. Working to complete an Obscore tool that reads a template with mapped model names to metadata, then reads in data products to build a table of Obscore entries for the dataset; just turned over needs review/testing; will implement on Chandra, have plans to make it available to the community.
 - Set up High Energy Data Group after initial meeting at May interop for discussions/use cases - 14 members.

 - JE/IE/MCD attended the Paris High Energy meeting virtually; the meeting was led by Mathieu Servillat. IE presented a CXC operations thread that highlighted Data Products and use of IVOA standards.
