 - JE said there will be a second hackathon at next Interop; will review issues identified and wok on action plan; scheduled on Wednesday
 - Gregory Montelet and Jeremy McCormick will be at the meeting; they are planning a small meeting before the hackathon to make sure the webtest solution can be used as a staging area
 - Media Group will conduct the ongoing maintenance and care of the website
 - JE said participants should be more involved with IVOA. A better description of the duties is warranted because the audience may think it's similar to producing the newsletter. SO concurs.
 - The newsletter hasn't been produced in a few years and it has come up in discussion.

7. Project Reports [Significant Events Only]

• China-VO: Einstein Probe Launched. The Sino-European partnership of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, ESA and the Max Planck Institute for Extraterrestrial Physics successfully launched the "lobster eye" Einstein Probe (EP) on Jan. 9, 2024. The EP is a mission dedicated to time-domain high-energy astrophysics. Its primary goals are to discover high-energy transients and monitor variable objects. China-VO team contributed great efforts to the EP Scientific Application System, including Time-domain Astronomical Information Center, proposal system, science platform, etc. More information is available at: https://nadc.china-vo.org/ep/

- Additional to previously implemented ConeSearch, SSAP and SLAP protocols, TAP, ADQL and UWS were implemented in 2023 for LAMOST DR9 and DR10.

- USVOA: The Chandra X-ray Center is pleased to announce the availability of Release 2.1 of the Chandra Source Catalog (CSC 2.1). This catalog covers roughly 730 square degrees of sky and contains 407,806 unique X-ray sources and over 1.3 million individual source detections identified in more than 15 thousand Chandra imaging observations released publicly prior to the end of 2021.
 - The catalog can be queried using multiple interfaces, including CSCview, WWT, simple web interface, and IVOA compliant services. The latter allow access from Jupyter notebooks via PyVO. For further information, consult the catalog webpage: http://cxc.cfa.harvard.edu/csc/.

- SG's topic is on blockchain technology to IVOA. JE said that isn't something to pitch in a WG/IG.
- MA said this topic isn't really being developed within IVOA and questions whether it's application to Exec.
- SO said SG can include a slide in the opening or closing presentations, unless SG has implemented something that links blockchain with IVOA standards.
- SG requests a vote so this is reflected in the minutes. SO said in light of the comments put forth by Exec, he's not keen to have a vote. The rest of Exec concurs.
- JJ and JE said this will be Severin Gaudet's last Interop, as well as François Bonnarel's, as they are both retiring. Exec should plan a small celebration.
- MA suggests reviewing the cadence and hybrid options for future Interops at a future Exec meeting.
- o CA asks how many people have registered for the Sydney meeting.
 - SO said ~75 in person, another 20-25 online.
 - JE noted that FC will attend in person but is registered as online, possibly due to a glitch or mistake with the registration for, which may adversely affect catering orders, etc.
- MA and JE noted one of the Interop days is not a full day, but is listed as such on the schedule.
