Discussion

1. Roll Call and Agenda

2. Review and approval of TM129 minutes

3. Review of Actions for TM130

- **TM127.1:** MM to discuss with FC, the CSP Chair, the recommendations for Interest Group participation in TCG discussions. **IN PROGRESS**
 - **Update:** Still in progress. The plan was to discuss this with FC at Interop, but she was not able to attend so this has been postponed.
- **TM129.1:** MA will discuss with JJ the open issues regarding the website; will share with Exec any items that need discussion and consensus. **DONE**
 - **Update:** They met by videocon; results from that discussion are deferred to website segment of this meeting.
- **TM129.2:** MH to add Mark Lacy to the Exec mailing list. **DONE**
- **TM129.3:** MH to post Exec committee roster to Twiki. **IN PROGRESS**
 - **Update:** This has been completed, but MH wants to do a final check for thoroughness.

4. Project Reports

- PF noted the USVOA slide she provided for JJ's State of the IVOA presentation has many updates that everyone should review.
- **China-VO**
 - The annual meeting, Astrominformatics and Virtual Observatory 2025, will be held November 26-29, 2025 in Hainan. 180+ participants have been registered. The theme of the meeting is "API&MCP." Driven by API&MCP, we hope to provide the community with FAIRable and AI-ready services. More information about the meeting is available at <https://nadc.china-vo.org/events/cvo2025>.
- **VObs.it (Italy)**
 - Organised the 1st Tech Forum for the Astro-CC project; it was held in INAF-OATs 7-9 October, offered enough room for standards and interoperability discussion, relevant for the EU partners: some content will be reported in Interop's sessions.

- Held a seminar at the Master on Data Management and Curation, organised for students and PhDs by Area Trieste and SISSA: IVOA history, status and challenges.
- Besides efforts in DAL, DSP, Radio groups, some efforts seems to restart on Theory topics (cross fingers).
- **ESA (Europe)**
 - Euclid iDR1 (internal Data Release 1) was released on 31 October 2026. The Euclid archive has been serving data through all standard data access protocols (TAP, [ADQL](#), [DataLink](#), SIA, SSA, [SODA](#), VOspace).
 - Big effort has been carried out to contact all VO Resources providers, indicating potential errors encountered when running the corresponding validators. Very good response rate and resources improvement. Dedicated presentation will be provided at the Operations WG session.
 - As part of this effort, we have started to fix our VO services from some of our archives, with various TAP services (JWST, Hubble, Integral, XMM-Newton) now being fully compliant.
 - A new version of the Euro-VO Registry 5.5 was released, with a new validator for the Object Observability Simple Access Protocol ([ObjObsSAP](#)) services, and some improvements of the other validators.
- **GAVO (Germany)**
 - GAVO's Heidelberg data centre keeps adding resources at a rate of a few per semester. A rather interesting one this semester is Carmenes DR1, which has radial velocity time series (for which we still need an equivalent to Ada's note on photometric time series) together with the spectra they were derived from. Also, the input format is very close to the new EPRV standard (although we output it in a VOTable serialisation).
 - We also keep maintaining our server package [DaCHS](#) and contribute to pyVO. In standards, we work on developing [VODataService](#) (e.g., safely distinguishing simulated from observational data), contributed to data origin, VOEvent registration, and much else. We also keep contributing to the UAT working group.
 - Organisationally, the GAVO Data Centre is going to move to Görlitz until 2028. It will grow into what will be called the GADC ("Görlitz Astronomical Data Centre"). We will be hiring a 5-head crew that will sustainably operate it (including the [reg.g-vo.org](#) [RegTAP](#) service), maintain [DaCHS](#), participate in the IVOA, do VO education in Germany and beyond, and so on.
- **SKAO**
 - Construction Progress - SKA Low, Australia AA0.5
 - 14,000 antennas deployed, about 10% of the total array, 5 dishes assembled for SKA Mid
 - Science Data Platform (SRCNet)
 - Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, the UK, China, Japan, SKAO small node, Canada and Italy have passed accreditation process for SRCNet nodes. Ingestion node in Australia
 - SRCNet 0.1 tested. First public version (Science Verification) expected for **Q1/2 2027**

- Use of multiple IVOA protocols (TAP, DataLink, metadata models)
- Helping with the evolution of IVOA to new authentication/authorisation mechanisms (tokens)
- Using CERN modules like Rucio for data management (like Vera Rubin). Rucio community Workshop organised by SKAO last week and they want to find a way to collaborate with IVOA (in particular on how to connect data with specific domain metadata)

5. TCG Report (MM)

- TCG met twice (as usual) since last Exec
 - Sept. 25 and Oct. 29
 - Plus, the hybrid meeting that just happened (Goerlitz, 13 Oct. 13:30 UTC)
- 2025 Northern Fall's Interop's program has been prepared and discussed
- Work has progressed on documents (on track docs here, see others below)
 - VOEvent-2.1: waiting a few changes before TCG re-review
 - [StandardRegExt-1.1](#) (that has been approved by Exec)
 - MANGO-1.0 undergoing review
 - [DALI-1.2](#) has just started RFC
 - [DocRegExt-1.0](#) has just started RFC
 - [DataOrigin-1.1](#) has been proposed as PEN
 - work in ongoing at various level in Vocabularies
 - full vocabularies
 - [VEPs](#)
 - UCDs vocabularisation
 - Radio & HE (&TD) [ObsCore](#) exts. are progressing
 - dedicated meetings and session
 - astronnet.ru decision
 - IGs coordination roles still to be discussed (but planned)
 - TCG pinged about roadmap preparation (and potentially thinking if it needs changes)
 - Documents Standards will need some time and brainstorm to get to something useful
 - tech-side might provide us some hints
 - see "dedicated" session on Sunday

7. IAU General Assembly/Working Group Report (BB)

- Preparing a focus session proposal for the GA in 2027.
 - All-day event on the VO and engagement of the broader astro community
 - Follow-on to very successful one-hour session at the last GA
 - Priya Hassan is co-PI; CC, MA & FC also contributing
 - BB was instructed to make sure some IAU representation in order for the proposal to be accepted
 - JJ asked: What is the high-level intention?
 - BB said the broad aim is to describe topics of interest to the broader IAU community. They shouldn't be provincial to a particular division, and the VO fits that criterion.
 - Funded by the IAU; no need to put up money if we are approved.
 - If we aren't approved, suggest having another division day session in Rome, though one hour doesn't allow deeper dives/discussion.
 - MA said IAU meetings are very busy and held over 10 days.
 - The South Africa meeting addressed the needs of the African continent.
 - In Rome, it will be very accessible to the VO and we're trying to put the VO on the agenda by having this focus session.
 - The one-hour session days are useful, but not as much as a focus session.
 - BB added that approved focus sessions get more publicity.
 - AN asked about video presentations and reaching data providers.
 - BB said we want to reach people who are interested in the VO but don't know how to proceed. Maybe they're setting up a data center and don't know about which standards to use; we're trying to find a balance as best we can.
 - MA & BB has presented in the past, so has Russ Taylor and Brad Sinko, and Priya Hassan.
- ➔ **Action:** BB will send the draft proposal to Exec for comments, with the understanding that it is still under development.

- MM waiting for DNS to be swapped from old to new server
 - web-new.ivoa.net; still needs a certificate.
 - Set up using CI directly from GitHub
- Deborah Baines is ready to put out a newsletter as soon as the website is available.
 - When that information is assembled, she'll try to publish the newsletter in January.
 - She's been working with Jeremy to understand how to publish the newsletter; she feels confident it's going to go smoothly.

- Deborah wants to do an annual newsletter scheduled for about a month after spring Interop; it will be fresh in people's minds and less difficult to get input.
- How to approve future changes:
 - Jeremy said it's pretty straightforward to create an approval group. For technical things and minor spelling or tiny edits, Jeremy feels comfortable doing the approval himself.
 - For more editorial content items, MA and JJ have agreed to be the points of contact.
 - That may be continuously a Chair or VC activity.
- There is a fair bit of content on the website that will need editing. As soon as the site is live, everyone should review the pages and flag areas for updates.

 - Lots of other details being addressed.

 - Who is the POC? CA suggested Andreas Wicencac because he expressed interest and also mentioned getting SO involved.
- CC is considering a proposal to host a future ADASS meeting in China.
 - ADASS 2027 (Northern Fall) will be held in Toronto; JJ said Interop may take place outside the city.
 - Locations for 2028 meetings are not yet determined.
