2. Minutes of FM53 and FM53S

4. Project Reports

Project reports from BRAVO, China-VO, ChiVO, GAVO, and VObs.it are included in the meeting wiki page.

In addition:

DS asked about the VAO transition in the US. JL briefly outlined the NASA follow-on project. The NASA centers (HEASARC, MAST, IPAC) will assume support of core VO services, monitor operations of US VO services, and have a liason for coordination with the IVOA. JL also noted that a request for AAS support for establishing US Virtual Observatory Alliance under the AAS Working Group on Astronomical Software was made in June. The AAS Council was generally positive toward the request, but asked the proposing group to obtain explicit community (data center) endorsement. PF added that after BHanisch raising the topic at the last VAO team meeting, a letter summarizing the situation and the endorsements was submitted to the AAS. A final AAS decision is still pending.

5. TCG Status

SG reported on the latest TCG activities. A telecom prior to the InterOp is planned. A message will be sent today.

6. Approval of new IVOA Recommendation(s) [Standing Item]

There were no IVOA recommendations to review.

7. Review terms up for Expiration

DS noted the IVOA Exec Chair and Vice Chair position will expire in Banff. It was noted by MG that the Vice Chair generally moves to Chair. FP/PF agreed that it is not written but that transition has always been the case.

8. IVOA Web Page and Document Repository transfer

MM provided an update on the Document and Repository transition. He noted that the domain name was changed at the end of June. Service transfer to Italy (Email, Wiki, Domain name) and India (Doc and repository) were completed in early September. He noted that if folks find any issues, to please report them. He is also preparing a technical note on the transfer of the IVOA Web Page and Document Repository components.

Note from JE: Reviewing notes from TM53, the backup system (offered by VO China in email on 18Dec13) was not discussed. Will suggest it is added to the agenda in Banff.

9. Review decisions needed for Trieste IVOA Meeting October 2016

FP highlighted that the Fall 2016 ADASS meeting will be in Trieste Italy. It is important in the budget and planning process to know whether the IVOA meeting will be paired with ADASS in Trieste. He noted that it is important to reach a decision in Banff.

SG asked if IVOA has the choice whether to meet before or after ADASS. After the Banff meeting the IVOA has had the chance to experience both and we may want to poll participants for input. FP said yes, that IVOA could make that decision.
