Several members of the committee provided the following highlights:

- PF/CXC/USVOA A business meeting for the USVOA is planned at the AAS on Thu, 5 Jan 2017, 2:00-3:30pm. All are welcomed. Also, CfA/CXC is supporting a AAS splinter meeting on Wed, 4 Jan 2017 9:30-11:30am titled Flexible Multi-dimensional Modeling of Complex Data in Astronomy. Fitting with Sherpa and Iris and VO compatibility will be demoed to participants along with a Q&A during the session.
- PF also noted that she visited the Integral Data Center in Geneva Switzerland in October. The folks there had an interest in IVOA and were considering becoming members. FG was interested in a contact and PF agreed to send the name to her.
