1. Roll Call and Agenda

The participants' names were recorded.

2. Media group topics

DB informed the Exec that the Media group had met via telecon and made the first steps in organizing the group and tasks. The following points were presented in a set of PowerPoint slides:

- 1st Media Group telecon was held on Thursday 20th July
- Meeting covered the following points: IVOA Newsletter, Social Media presence, Web Pages, VO Portal, Outreach, Media Group Charter
- DB offered the Exec a copy of the meeting notes Exec accepted
- The group is concentrating on 4 main areas, with the following people taking the lead in each area:
 - IVOA Newsletter (Debbie Baines)
 - Social Media presence (Simon O'Toole)
 - Web Pages (Jamie Budynkiewicz)
 - Outreach (Bruce Berriman)
- Discussions and actions:
 - IVOA Newsletter: continues as usual, next version for just after the Santiago Interop.
 - Social Media presence: We're drafting a proposal for the Exec for the social media IVOA presence.
 - Web Pages: We're reviewing these with the question: What do astronomers want to get out of the website? Our reviews will be put into a proposal to the Exec.
 - VO Portal: We've asked the CSP to take the lead. Media group will contribute to a proposal where needed.
 - Outreach: Bruce is involved in some outreach coordination therefore we hope to coordinate activities with those of NASA archives (NAVO), USVOA as well as other IVOA partners. We'll have more news in the Fall. Jamie raised the topic of IVOA publicity material at conferences (pens, stickers, etc). IVOA partners could give these out at their booths. Has the Exec ever considered this?
 - Media Group Charter: We're drafting a version of the Media Group charter (for Santiago Interop).

PF noted that it would be good to have an outreach session at the Fall Interop. It would be a good time with ADASS to interface with NASA and others. She suggested that folks should start thinking about an Education session in Santiago and asked DB in coordination with CC to lead it. MG noted that there are few plenary slots at the fall meeting and it would need to be discussed when putting the schedule together.

The FM title is "IAU's role on global astronomy outreach, the latest challenges and bridging different communities". It will be 4 sessions (1.5h each) over 3 days. The meeting organization is still ongoing; CC also noted that there was an IAU/EAC sponsored first International Symposium on Education in Astronomy and Astrobiology (Jul 3-7, 2017) in Utrecht, Netherlands and that the meeting was very positive and successful. CC gave an Education talk. The next meeting is in two years in Spain and CC will be co-chair of that meeting.)

PF raised the idea that the cost could be shared by Major Data Centers – an action was assigned for Data Centers to look into cost sharing).
