#### 5. Overall TCG status

BD.

- Two standards will be sent to exec this week for approval
- Three standards are waiting for a few TCG approvals; may be sent to exec in 1-2 weeks.
- Some progress was made on the Provenance Data Model; the 2<sup>nd</sup> RFC period is over today, 3 September 2019; the TGC did not

review it yet; there are still a lot of (minor) comments that need to be fixed and it is not ready for recommendation yet; TCG chair and vice chair, working group chair, author and editor are all involved in trying to finish this.

## 6. Approval of new IVOA Recommendation

PD: no new recommendation yet but some will be sent in the next few weeks before the meeting.

## 7. Planning for renewal of IVOA Exec Chair and Vice Chair roles

MA: Exec Chair and Vice Chair roles both need to be filled; a telecon of most of the previous chairs was held to discuss potential nominations for both roles; the process is to announce the need of nomination during this current telecon with the goal of choosing at the next interop meeting in Groningen.

GF and FP: suggest to have another telecon between previous chairs before the interop meeting.

#### 8. IVOA codes of conduct

MA described various reasons why the topic of a code of conduct is coming up now.

The discussion highlighted that as a mature organization, IVOA should have its own code of conduct to be followed in all kinds of interactions, including by email and in person during meetings.

The Exec agree that this is important and need to be drafted soon.

MA and CA agreed to start drafting a code of conduct document.

# 9. Groningen Interop meeting agenda

JE:

- the TCG is looking at the different topics to decide for some few main sessions beside splinter meetings; a possible main session could be related to radio astronomy with the contribution of the local astronomers if interested;

# 12. Future Interops

MA: Interop meetings have usually been hosted by IVOA member organizations with local financial support. It is going to be more likely in the future that extra financial support will be needed, and when an IVOA meeting is attached to an ADASS conference there are extra expenses involved to host the IVOA at the same location as ADASS. E.g., for the IVOA meeting connected to the Nov 2020 ADASS meeting in Granada the local organizers (including ES) have indicated that financial support would be needed for IVOA meeting rooms etc. In the past, IVOA member organizations have provided some financial support for the meeting expenses (e.g., sponsorship of the Groningen meeting). Going forward it may be necessary for the local organizers to request a registration fee for IVOA meetings to support the organization.

CA and FP: ADASS LOC and POC feel the pressure of organizing the IVOA interop meetings.

Exec members agree on asking a registration fee of the order of \$50-100 per meeting depending on the needs and length of the meeting. This information can be forwarded to the ADASS LOC/POC via CA and FP.

For the Sydney meeting, MA relayed the information that SO is looking for local sponsorship, and that the need of a registration fee may also come up for this meeting.

SO provided (by email) information on the Sydney meeting dates: May 4-8, 2020 is the preferred, and May 11-15, 2020 is currently a back-up.
