Some discussion is still required and the plan is to issue SAMP WD 1.1 for Baltimore so it can start the RFC process afterwards.



2.2.1 SIAP 1.0 (PR START 04/08)


SIAP 1.0 WD update should be ready by 10/09 as mainly cleaning of the existing WD dating from 2004.

2.3 DM


2.3.1 AMLDM WD 0.6 (14/09)


2.3.3 PHOTDM WD 0.1 (15/10)

2.4 GWS


2.4.1 VOSI (PR START 30/06)


2.4.2 UWS (PR START 01/08)


2.4.3 VOSPACE 1.1 (PR START 18/07)

Updated VOSpace WD 1.1 should be issued on 15/09.




2.4.4 BP (PR START 31/07)


2.5.1 REGISTRY INTERFACE (PR START 07/08)

The updated Registry 1.0 WD will be issued on 15/09.




2.5.2 VODATASERVICE (PR START 15/08)

These consist only of new words, there is no change to the existing UCDs. The UCD 1+ WD 1.0 will be issued on 04/09.







VOEvent 2.0 is now working towards a schedule to go to PR mid January 2009.




2.10 Standing Committee on Standards and Processes


