
- pyvo 1.0 now does auth and has working examples for GAIA and CADC
- YouCat uploading tables to TAP, which requires good auth
- Auth has lots of challenges (pun intended):
 - OAuth2 is the standard, but uses the browser, which makes it hard for CLI apps
 - Group Management Service helps standardize how to find out if someone is a member of a group (in working draft, comments accepted)
 - Best practices for auth in general are still an open problem
 - CADC and GAIA use cookies, LSST does tokens
 - SecurityMethod needs more information to make it useful for being able to authenticate
