Standard updates



- UWS 1.1
 - At least 2 implementations (CDS/ARI, CADDC)
 - Cleaned and updated document for PR within the end of June
 - Main and final decision during the session I
 - ?WAIT = -1 to be used to signal “indefinite” wait in the blocking behavior

Standard updates (2)



- VOSpace 2.1
 - The working draft will be completed with the comments and feedback received during this interop:
 - More text explaining use of SecurityMethod
 - findNodes operation to include old listNodes behaviour
 - XSD/XML to comply to new approach
 - After a short review period, the document will go to PR, sometime before Sydney



Standard updates (and one more)



- SSO 2.0
 - Update from 1.01 to 2.0
 - Major revision with removed parts and new adds
 - Following the discussion in Session 3, minor updates needed

Standard updates (last)



- VOSI 1.0 to 1.1 or 2.0
 - Exact version update will depend on Ops and XML Schema

Result of the splinter meeting / XML Schema



- The namespace of the associated schema is to remain the same (1.0) even though some optional elements have been added
- A note will be written describing general policy for schema evolution that would be applicable to other IVOA standards (Paul in charge of it)

- VOSpace 2.1 – RFC between Sesto and Sydney
- SSO 2.0 – RFC between Sesto and Sydney
- VOSI 1.1 or 2.0 – WD after Sesto
- Note on Authorization: no discussion in Sesto, a primary draft before Sydney
- Note about “How to implement a VOSpace” – if people have time to do it !
