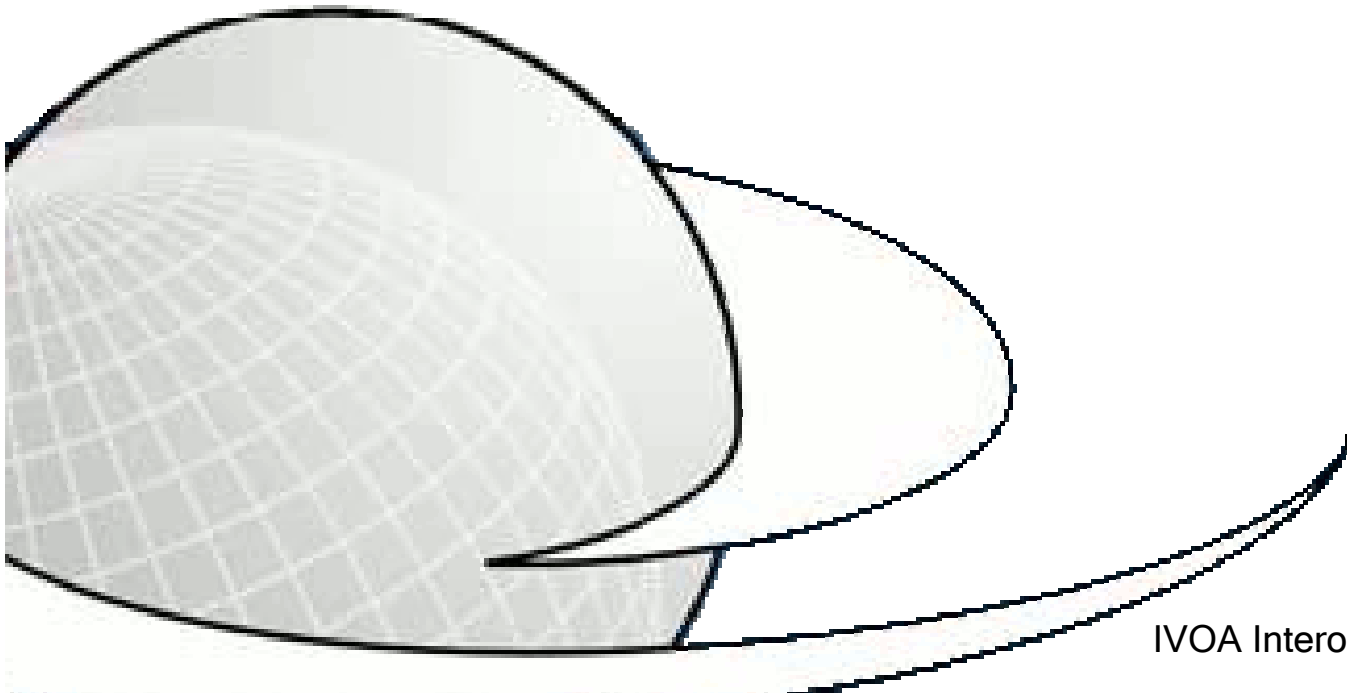

Status of standards



- Call to TCG to complete review of Registry Interfaces v1.0
- It was agreed to move **VODataService to RFC**
 - Recommended some naming changes
 - Add utype, description tags to foreign key descriptions
 - RFC to begin by end of next week
- VOStandard:
 - sufficient to support VOspace
 - Question if VOEvent's plans for using IVOA identifiers is compliant

Interoperability Issues



- Harvesting
 - For the most, part things are working well
 - Most issues are dealt with easily on case-by-case basis
 - Noticed some registries have fallen out of compliance; need regular validation
 - Not all registries are using RofR in an automated, regular way
 - Human latency for adding new registry
 - Call for convention on use of spaces with certain metadata (identifier)
- Searching
 - Need for search interoperability is now
 - applications want to maintain a list of searchable registries
 - When primary registry is not available, can fail over to next one in list
 - Need to support interoperable advanced search
 - Need to document list of common searches, be sure we support them
 - Need automated search validator

Action: create document of conventions and tips for registry providers

Curation Practices and Tools



- FM-19A, study of registry and service curation made recommendations
 - *Called for curation tools to check compliance*
 - *Non-compliant resources differentiated in registry*
 - Some progress made but not full progress
 - Usage metrics are very helpful, critical
 - Projects are planning for comprehensive evaluation of resource descriptions and underlying services (ESAVO, NVO)
- Service Validators are important
 - Some are now available
 - SIA, CSC, Registry Harvesting; services, library available
 - Others are planned
 - SSA, Registry Search
 - ESAVO: plans for a scriptable library
 - Publishers have found them very valuable
 - Note: Validators can and do have errors in them
 - Having redundant validators is good!

Curation Practices and Tools



- NVO has been monitoring standard services across all of the VO over the last year
 - < 7% pass as fully compliant
 - Large number of failed services have a few easily fixed errors
 - Beginning to converse with publishers; they appreciate it!
 - Sometimes validator is wrong, sometimes the protocol is “wrong” (or ambiguous).
- Discussion Points
 - Need to make use of validationLevel in registry
 - Encouraging Full Compliance is paramount
 - Can we identify useful but slightly non-compliant services?
 - Can we incorporate development of validators into the standardization process for service protocols?
 - We need to develop shared quality standards *on the IVOA Level*
 - We need to develop metrics for success *on the IVOA Level*

Future Directions



- Need to revamp the advanced interface
 - Other ways to do constraint-based queries?
 - VOTable output?
- Need contributors
 - Several documents in queue; need writers
 - Identified a liason to outreach community for AVM
 - Need brains with innovative ideas
