Current scientific priorities at IVOA



Current priorities (status and remaining work to be assessed):

- Time-domain astronomy
- Multi-dimensional data: spectral or time cubes (sky + wavelength/ frequency)

Topics discussed:

★ Data discoverability and access:

- assess and if needed try to improve data discoverability through the registry (can we gauge what our users think of this issue before the next InterOp?)
- make software available to data providers to link to such registry
- which steps toward realizing the vision of making single-point access to all the community's data available from any IVOA client?



Other possible future priorities:

- Engage with the astronomical Python community!
- Standards for science platforms and their interoperability
- Efficient access to large amounts of survey data
- Others?

Possible next steps:

- CSP will define some "data interoperability science use cases" to bring VO capabilities where the astronomers are
 - naturally derived from what VO technology allows

- organize a hackathon on python (astropy +?) and VO, encouraging open participation
 - a IVOA@Paris2019 hackathon to jumpstart this process?
