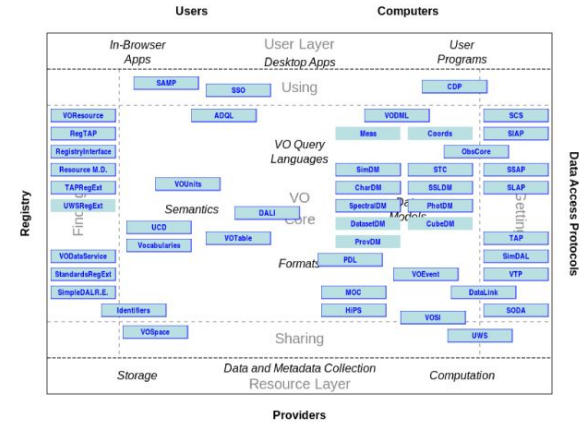
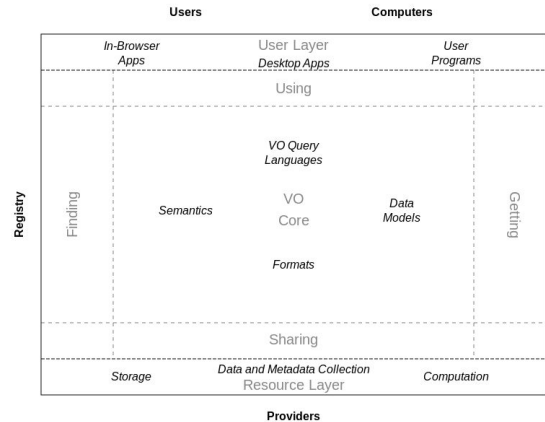
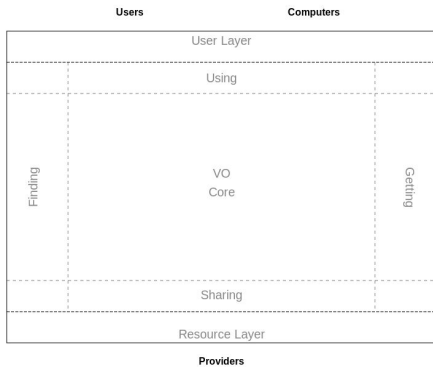
# Standards currently in the RFC

- Proposed Recommendations
  - Provenance DM 1.0 (closed)
  - SSLDM 2.0
  - Measurements DM 1.0
  - Coordinates DM 1.0
- TCG review of ProvDM waiting for updated doc
- “STC2” models require revision to resolve issue found during WD-Transform-1.0 implementation
- TCG review of those models and implementations to begin soon
